

## What To Expect: PGES PTA Spring Fling 2018, Friday, April 20, 5:30pm

### How much does this event cost?

The movie is provided for **free** to Flyers families by the PGES PTA. The PTA hopes you enjoy our community evening together watching *Coco*.

### What should I bring? School Supplies Service Project

Please bring a few school supplies to donate to your fellow Flyers who need them for the 2018-2019 school year. Most wanted items are: dry erase markers (black); single subject notebooks; pre-sharpened #2 pencils; colored pencils; 3 subject notebooks; 3 ring binders 1 inch; composition notebooks; highlighters and Crayola crayons. There will be two boxes set up to drop your school supplies.

### When does it start?

*Coco* will begin at dusk (somewhere between 6:30 and 7:00 pm) as soon as it is dark enough to start the movie. We realize it is a late night for our youngsters and will start as soon as possible.

### What will I do before the movie starts?

Not only will you be able to peruse the raffle items and purchase tickets, there will be music and martial arts. DJ B-Eley will be DJing so you can dance and/or enjoy the music. [Master Chang Martial Arts](#) will have a bounce house and demonstrations. The PTA will hold a brief meeting at 6pm.

### What Can I eat?

The following food and beverages will be available for purchase:

- **Randy's Pizza**, cheese or pepperoni, for \$5.00 a slice (includes a bottle of water). Pizza will be ordered a couple of times to allow people to eat fresh, hot pizza as they connect with fellow Flyers.
- **Kona Ice** (price varies)
- **Popcorn** for \$1.00 per bag. Popcorn will be freshly popped throughout the evening. I can't wait to smell the fresh popcorn in the air.
- **Bottled water** for \$1.00.

You are welcome to bring your own picnic basket. No food in the gym. Obviously, alcohol is not allowed.

### How can I pay?

We will be accepting cash, checks to PGES PTA and/or charge cards. Charge cards will carry a \$1.00 service fee each time you use them. Unfortunately, this is necessary to recoup the costs to use a charge card reader through our bank. So please keep this in mind as you purchase things.

### Where will we sit?

This is an outside venue (weather permitting). Feel free to bring chairs or blankets depending on your preference. Make yourself comfortable in the area marked for the event being mindful of your neighbors.

### What to do if my child is overwhelmed by the event?

We will have a Quiet Room available for students who need to remove themselves for a period of time to enjoy the event. This is a parent supervised room and you will need to remain with your student. It will be in the Kindergarten hall and clearly marked. Please only use this room if your student needs a moment of solitude to ensure this is effective for those who need the space to attend the event.

## Housekeeping

There will be garbage cans throughout the event. Please use them for any garbage you have. Restrooms in the school will be available. Please use the ones nearest the event to help keep the building secure and minimize the need to clean after the event. Do not bring food or beverages into the gym.

## Raffles: How will I know if I won a raffle prize?

We will be pulling the winners of all items on April 20<sup>th</sup> at 8:30pm. You do not need to be present to win. We just need a clear phone number and name on the ticket so we can contact you after the event. There will be a line marked with orange cones to line up in to receive your winnings. The teacher experiences will be pulled late in the evening so you may receive a text or call that evening or the next day. The winners will also be posted on the PTA website by the following Wednesday.
